### History

In the northern part of the Beaujolais, on the granitic soil of the slopes surrounding Fleurie, the vineyards of Fleurie produce the most feminine of all the Beaujolais wines, also known as the "Queen of Beaujolais". According to the local tradition this is due to the influence of the Virgin of Fleurie who watches over the vines from the hilltop where she stands...

Domaine de la Presle is located on the hill side on top which there is the little chapel dedicated to this Virgin in a small vale looking south east.



### Terroir

This cru is located next to Chiroubles, Morgon and Moulin à Vent.

While we have poor granitic soil next to the "Black Virgin" chapel, we can find argile in the eastern part of the estate.



### Wine

- Colour: garnet colour  
 - Nose: aromas of violets, roses and iris  
 - Mouth: Elegant, full bodied and velvety smooth. This wine is said to be one of the most feminine in style among the Crus. And it is perhaps thanks to the Virgin of Fleurie perched at the top of the hillside.



### To be served with

Our Fleurie Domaine de la Presle could be appreciated young or can be aged 3 to 5 years.

Best served at 12 to 14 ° C on roast lamb, poultry, and white meat.
