Location : Change (near Santenay).

Soil : Siliceous, chalk, marl, clay

History

The vineyard of Hautes Côtes de Beaune, is situated parallel to Côtes de Beaune, set on the hillsides at an average altitude of 300 meters.

Domaine des Vignes des Demoiselles is situated on the hill and benefits from an excellent exposure South / South East. Most of the vineyard was planted 40 years ago.

Soil

Siliceous, chalk, marl, clay.



Wine

- Colour: A dark garnet red colour

- Nose: Elegant nose, fresh, with cherry aromas

- Taste : Soft in the mouth, elegant, mature and well balanced between tannins and fruit flavours.



Service

Aromas and flavours will be best appreciated served at a temperature at 14 to 16°C.

This wine should be a good companion to red meat, grilled or roasted, soft game, and cheeses.
