



## SYRAH PAYS D'OC

**Appellation:** Pays d'Oc

**Location:** In the South of France, Languedoc-Roussillon region.

**Soil:** alluvial deposit

**Grape variety:** syrah

**Harvest:** mechanical.

**Wine-making:** fermentation at a cooler temperature

**Ageing:** in vat and oak



### **History**

This Syrah is a Pays d'Oc from the Peyriac area in the Languedoc-Roussillon region.

During the past ten years the South of France has undergone major changes and the cheap and very productive grape varieties have been replaced by noble ones, such as this Syrah.



### **Soil**

This wine is grown on the alluvial deposit of the Aude river.



### **Wine**

- Colour : Intense red with purple highlights.
- Nose: Candied fruit aromas with hints of violet and anise.
- Taste: Powerful mouth with smooth tannins.



### **To serve**

This wine should be good when paired with red or white meats, and cheeses.

It is ready to drink but can also age 2 or 3 years.

To be served between 17 and 18°C.
