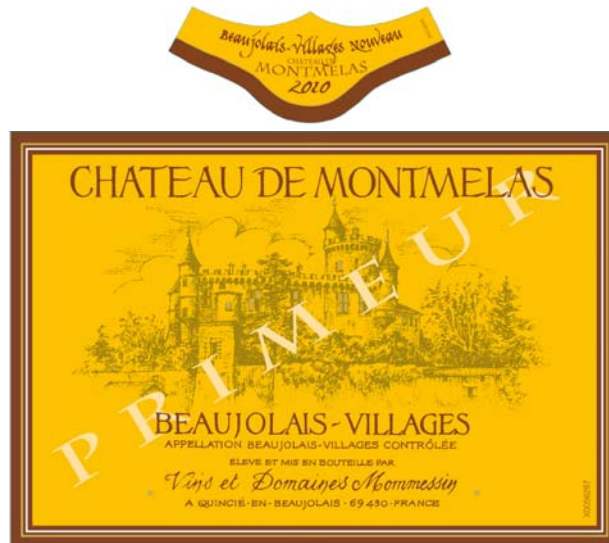




## BEAUJOLAIS-VILLAGES PRIMEUR 2010 « Château de Montmelas »



*The Château de Montmelas as it stands today was built in the 14<sup>th</sup> century. It first belonged to the Lords of Beaujeu, then to the Bourbons, until being bought in 1565 by the d'Harcourt family to whom it still belongs today.*

*The partnership between the chateau and Mommessin has now been in existence for over a century. This is one of the most beautiful Beaujolais residences. The chateau towers overlook the estate's 50 hectares of vines that spread over the surrounding slopes of exceptional terroir.*

### ⇒ **CHARACTERISTICS :**

The grapes come from a selection of the best plots for Nouveau wines. We look for forthright, open fruit and highlight the ever present personality of the Montmelas terroir by using different vinification techniques.

The 2010 harvest took place between 20 September au 4 October under ideal weather conditions.

### ⇒ **2010 VINTAGE TASTING NOTES :**

Ruby red in colour with violet highlights, the nose is elegant with notes of red and black fruits (blackcurrant, blueberries, raspberries and blackberries).

The aromas found on the nose are echoed on the palate, underpinned by fruitiness that makes for a delectable Primeur.

### ⇒ **HOW TO ENJOY IT :**

This powerful, structured wine is a reflection of its terroir. It is a marvellous accompaniment to dishes like bœuf bourguignon, steak and kidney pie and vegetable stew with light dumplings.

### ⇒ **SERVICE :**

Enjoy this wine at 14 to 18° C.
